TRAVEL INFORMATION

There is NO PARKING at the ground or at Horsham Park & Ride for this game.

A free shuttle bus will be operated from Horsham train station and Horsham bus station to the ground. Starting at 17:15 with 6 busses an hour.

By presenting a match ticket, spectators can also travel on the 98 bus free of charge.

Spectators are asked to park at the following car parks and then use the shuttle bus:

BT Exchange Car Park Chichester Terrace, Horsham RH12 1DJ

North Street Public Car Park, North Street, Horsham RH12 9SX

IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT ALL SPECTATORS TRAVEL TO THE STADIUM AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE TO ENSURE THAT YOU DO NOT MISS ANY OF THE ACTION

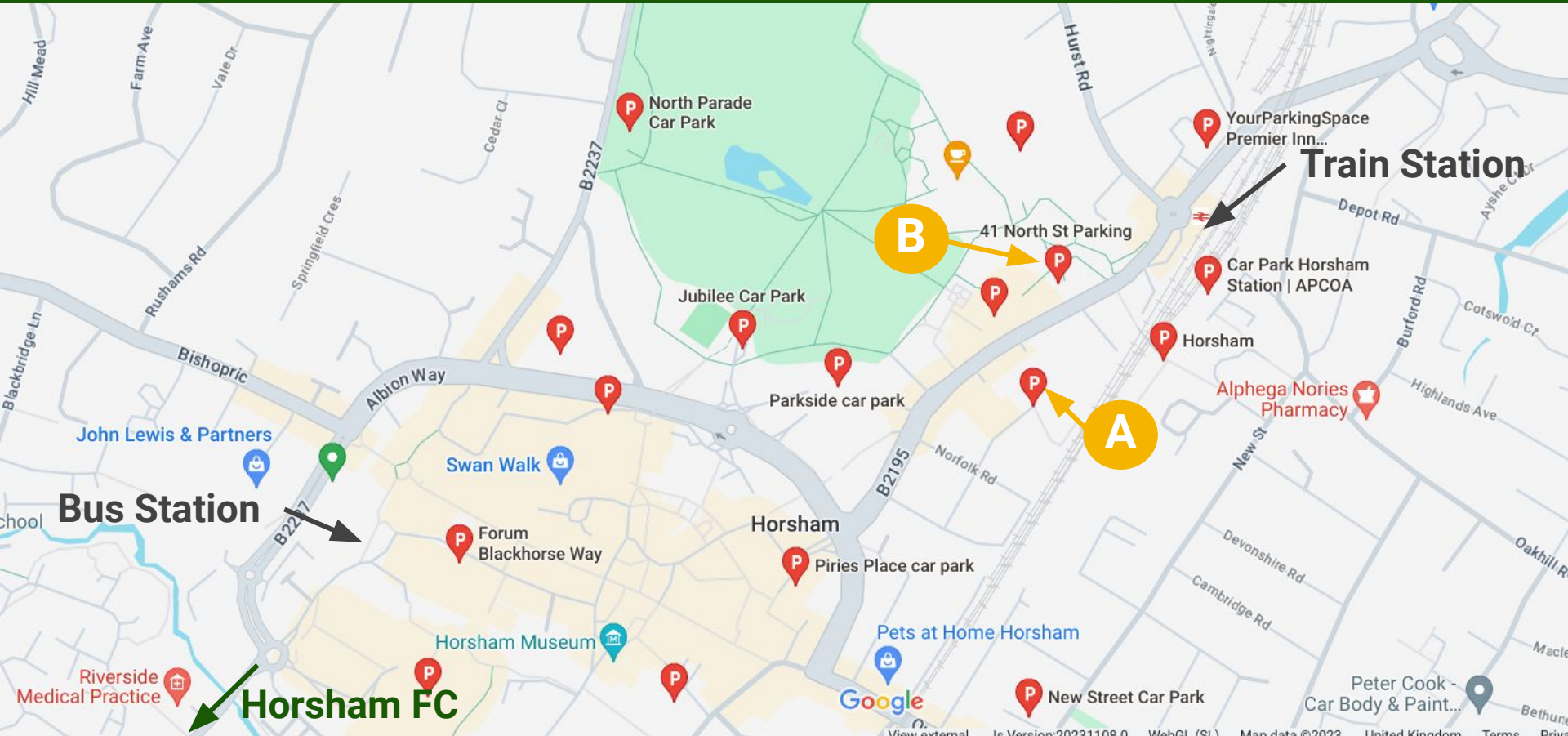
PARKING

Primary Car Park - A:

BT Exchange Car Park North Street,
Horsham RH12 1DJ

Secondary Car Park - B:

41 North Street Parking, Horsham
RH12 1RN



SHUTTLE BUS

Multiple shuttle bus will operate every 25 minutes from 17:15 onwards. The shuttle bus will start at Horsham train station before picking up at the bus station, before making its way to the ground. There will be 6 shuttle busses an hour.

With a valid match ticket, spectators can also use the 98 bus from the bus station to the ground

After the match the bus will make the same journey in reverse.



HOME FANS

Turnstiles open at 17:30

Home fans with both seated and standing tickets should use turnstile 1, 2 & 3.

AWAY FANS

Turnstiles open at 17:30

Away fans with STANDING tickets should use turnstile 5 for entrance to the away end and away fan zone.

Away fans with SEATED tickets should use turnstile 4 for entrance.

ALCOHOL

In accordance with FA rules, no alcohol can be served or consumed in view of the pitch. This means no alcohol may be taken out of the club house or Fan Zones.

The clubhouse bar will be open, but with no view of the action on the pitch. No alcohol may be taken out of the clubhouse. Once at capacity the clubhouse will operate a strict one-in, one-out policy.

A 'Home Fan Zone', serving alcohol, will be in operation behind the Main Stand. Access to the Fan Zone will be via the ground, following entry through the turnstiles.

A 'Away Fan Zone', serving alcohol will be in operation to the right of the clubhouse. Access to the Fan Zone will be via the away turnstile

REFRESHMENTS AND MERCHANDISE

There will be a number of outlets around the stadium serving a range of hot and cold food, snacks and drinks.

Matchday programmes, 50/50 raffle tickets and various merchandise will also be available throughout the ground

Food Outlets:

- Food hatch, to the left of the Club House
- Pizza Craft serving Pizza in the Home Fan Zone
- Hot pies/sausage rolls in the Away Fan Zone
- A BBQ will be set up in the Home Fan Zone



TOILETS in four locations:

- 1) Inside the clubhouse;
- 2) In the signposted toilet block close to the main turnstiles;
- 3) a set of portaloos behind the Main Stand in the Fan Zone;
- 4) a set of portaloos in the away fan section.
